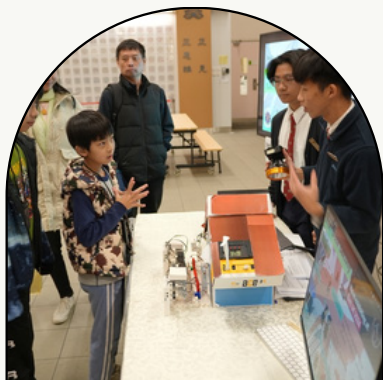
PREPARATION

Global EdTech showcase, innovation hub, networking and inspiring education future.



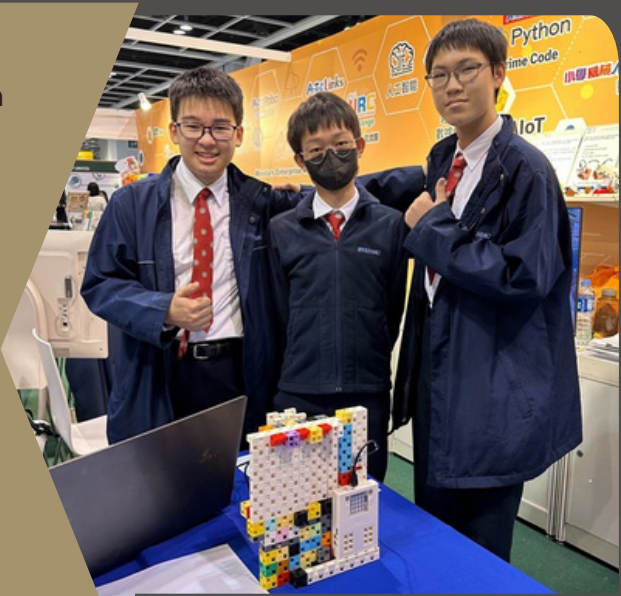

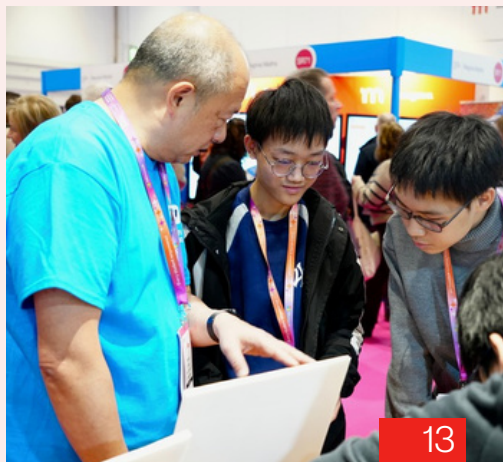

We engaged in fruitful exchanges, showcasing our products to international visitors. While the two-day event was demanding, it yielded a wealth of knowledge and valuable feedback.



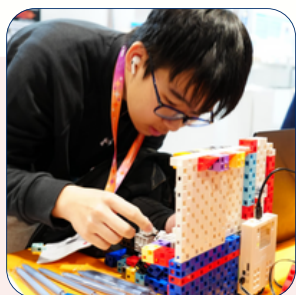

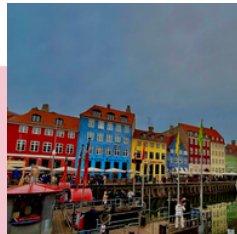

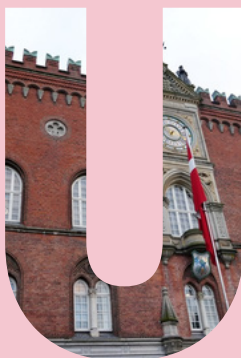




Experimentarium

Within the vibrant space, interactive exhibits ignited our curiosity, while glowing displays and hands-on experiments introduced us to physics and Danish technology.

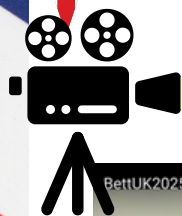
